## **Opening Remarks**

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Youth Committee (“YC”) and government representatives to the 11th meeting of YC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had not received any notice of absence before the meeting.

### **I. Confirmation of Minutes of the 10th Meeting of Youth Committee**

3. The Secretariat had earlier circulated the draft minutes of the last meeting to all Members. Members had not raised any other comments before and during the meeting. The minutes of the 10th meeting were confirmed.

### **II. Visit of JCI Peninsula to the Youth Committee under Kwun Tong District Council**

4. The Chairman welcomed the representatives of JCI Peninsula (“JCI”) to the meeting.

5. The representatives of JCI introduced the background of the organisation and its past activities.

6. The Vice-chairman enquired about potential collaboration between JCI and YC.

7. The representative of JCI stated that JCI planned to organise the event “Dialogue with the

Future: Tomorrow’s Conservation Leaders”, which aimed to deepen students’ understanding of the community by promoting heritage conservation. JCI expressed its hope to collaborate with Members or other local organisations to hold workshops and other activities to enhance students’ understanding of the cultural characteristics of Kwun Tong District. In addition, JCI intended to invite young leaders to serve as mentors, leading students in community conservation activities, and hoped to strengthen cooperation with schools in the district in the future.

8. The Vice-chairman suggested that JCI collaborate with the Kwun Tong District Youth Community Building Committee and the Kwun Tong District Youth Development and Civic Education Committee.

9. Members suggested that JCI maintain liaison with the Kwun Tong District Office and the KTDC Secretariat.

10. The Chairman enquired about the details of the event “Dialogue with the Future: Tomorrow’s Conservation Leaders”.

11. The representative of JCI explained that JCI had co-organised the event “Dialogue with the Future: Tomorrow’s Conservation Leaders” with different tertiary institutions and secondary schools, with the aim of cultivating visionary future leaders and enhancing the younger generation’s sense of cultural belonging and community involvement.

12. The Chairman thanked the representatives of JCI for attending the meeting.

13. Members noted the agenda item.

**III. Number of Children Referred to Public Sector Primary and Secondary Schools in Kwun Tong District Provided by the Education Bureau**  
**(KTDC YC Paper No. 9/2025)**

14. The Chairman welcomed Mr TAI Man-chun, Allen, Senior School Development Officer (Kwun Tong) 2 of the Education Bureau (“EDB”), for attending the YC meeting for the first time.

15. The representative of EDB presented the paper.

16. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

16.1 Members expressed concern about the arrangements for referring students moving into

the Light Public Housing (“LPH”) in Kwun Tong District to public sector primary and secondary schools within the district.

16.2 Members enquired about the mechanism for referring students aged 16 or above for school admission.

17. The representative of EDB responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:

17.1 Students living in the LPH: The representative of EDB stated that EDB had earlier provided referral services for students moving into the LPH in Kwun Tong District, and the figures set out in the paper had already included the relevant cases. The representative of EDB pointed out that the surplus school places in the district were sufficient to meet the demand for referral services. Under the existing mechanism, EDB would, as far as possible, arrange for students unable to study in their original district to attend nearby schools.

17.2 Students aged 16 or above: The representative of EDB stated that EDB would regularly provide information on the vacancy situation of schools on its website starting from the 2025/26 school year to facilitate parents in applying for their preferred schools for their children.

(Post-meeting note: Starting from the 2025/26 school year, EDB had introduced the following enhancement measures:

- (a) Providing information on public sector secondary school vacancies to facilitate parents in submitting admission applications for their children;
- (b) Regularly releasing information on the vacancy situation in public sector secondary schools across different districts on EDB’s website to enhance transparency; and
- (c) Extending the placement assistance services of the Regional Education Offices to cover Secondary 4 to Secondary 6.)

18. Members suggested that EDB strengthen communication with other departments regarding student referral matters and actively facilitate liaison among different schools.

19. The representative of EDB noted Members’ suggestions.

(Post-meeting note: In view of the public housing development in the district, EDB would liaise with relevant departments to review whether school places in the district could meet the demand, and the relevant work would continue.)

20. Members noted the paper.

**IV. Report on Youth Crimes in Kwun Tong District from July to August 2025**  
**(KTDC YC Paper No. 10/2025)**

21. The representative of the Hong Kong Police Force (“HKPF”) presented the paper.

22. Members enquired about the definition of “serious drug offences”.

23. The representative of HKPF responded that if the quantity of drugs involved in a case exceeded the prescribed amount, the case would be classified as a serious drug case and referred to the police’s Crime Wing for follow-up. The Narcotics Bureau and the Kwun Tong District School Liaison Officers of HKPF would continue to promote anti-drug information to young people through different channels, and the Kwun Tong District and the Sau Mau Ping District of HKPF would collaborate with the Kwun Tong District Fight Crime Committee to organise various anti-drug activities.

24. Members noted the paper.

**V. Any Other Business**

**Partner Events under 2025 youthfest@HK**

25. The Secretary introduced the Partner Events under 2025 youthfest@HK, and invited Members to actively support and assist in promoting the programme.

26. The Chairman enquired about the application procedures.

27. The Secretary replied that Members may download the application form and access programme information from the “youthfest@HK” website. The Secretariat would provide further details to Members after the meeting.

(Post-meeting note: The Secretariat had sent the application information for the Partner Events to Members after the meeting.)

28. The Chairman called on Members to actively promote the programme.

29. Members did not raise other items for discussion.

**VI. Date of Next Meeting**

30. The next meeting was scheduled to be held at 2:30 p.m. on 2 December 2025 (Tuesday).

(Post-meeting note: The next meeting had been rescheduled for 18 November 2025 (Tuesday).)

31. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:23 p.m.
