Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Youth Committee (“YC”) and government representatives to the 12th meeting of YC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had received a notice of absence from Mr TANG Wing-chun before the meeting. YC consented to the above application for absence due to its compliance with Order 64 (1) of the Kwun Tong District Council Standing Orders.

I. Confirmation of Minutes of the 11th Meeting of Youth Committee

3. The Secretariat had earlier circulated the draft minutes of the last meeting to all Members. Members had not raised any other comments before and during the meeting. The minutes of the 11th meeting were confirmed.

II. Number of Children Referred to Public Sector Primary and Secondary Schools in Kwun Tong District Provided by the Education Bureau (KTDC YC Paper No. 11/2025)

4. The representative of the Education Bureau (“EDB”) presented the paper.

5. Members pointed out that many students had already moved into the Light Public Housing (“LPH”) in the Sam Choi area and suggested that EDB coordinate with relevant departments to review the transportation arrangements in the area so as to meet students’ commuting needs.

6. The representative of EDB noted the views and would follow up on Members' suggestions with the relevant departments.

(Post-meeting note: EDB had relayed the above suggestion to the Transport Department ("TD"). TD replied that it noted Members' views on the public transport services serving the Choi Hing Road LPH area and had reminded the relevant public transport operators ("operators") to closely monitor passenger demand in the area. TD had also reminded the operators to provide services in accordance with the schedule of service and to flexibly deploy resources to meet the travel needs of passengers in the area. TD would closely monitor the public transport services in the above area and review and follow up with the operators as appropriate.)

7. Members noted the paper.

III. Report on Youth Crimes in Kwun Tong District from September to October 2025 **(KTDC YC Paper No. 12/2025)**

8. The representative of the Hong Kong Police Force ("HKPF") presented the paper.

9. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

9.1 Members suggested that HKPF strengthen patrols in the district and enhance crime prevention publicity and education targeting young people.

9.2 Members suggested that HKPF step up the promotion of anti-scam information to young people to heighten their vigilance.

10. The representative of HKPF responded to Members' views and enquiries as follows:

10.1 Strengthening patrols and publicity: During the winter precaution period, the Kwun Tong District and Sau Mau Ping District of HKPF would step up patrols in the district. They would also collaborate with the Junior Police Call ("JPC") to disseminate crime prevention messages to residents through the distribution of promotional leaflets and other means.

10.2 Anti-scam publicity: In addition to organising anti-deception talks at schools, HKPF would deploy the Anti-Scam Promotional Truck and, together with members of the Kwun Tong District Fight Crime Committee, organise a variety of activities in the district to enhance young people's awareness of scam prevention.

11. Members noted the paper.

IV. Any Other Business

2025 Legislative Council General Election

12. The representative of the Kwun Tong District Office briefed Members on the publicity work carried out earlier in the district to encourage youth participation in the 2025 Legislative Council General Election (“LegCo Election”).

13. The representative of HKPF also briefed Members on the relevant publicity activities conducted by the two districts of HKPF and the JPC in support of the LegCo Election.

V. Date of Next Meeting

14. The next meeting was scheduled to be held at 2:30 p.m. on 3 February 2026 (Tuesday).

15. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m.
