

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council
District Facilities and Works Committee**

The second meeting (2025) of the Sai Kung District Council District Facilities and Works Committee (DFWC) was held on 11 March. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Report on management of recreation and sports facilities in Sai Kung District from January to February 2025 by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department

Suggest installing water filling stations at East Dam and West Dam of High Island Reservoir to enhance tourism-support facilities and promote environmental protection

8. DFWC noted the written replies from the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) and the Water Supplies Department (WSD), and asked AFCD and WSD to follow up Members' views.

9. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest constructing a boardwalk to connect Lei Yue Mun Waterfront, with a view to extending the Tseung Kwan O Waterfront Promenade

10. DFWC noted the written reply from the Development Bureau (DEVB) and the Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD), and asked DEVB and CEDD to note Members' views.
