

Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council
District Facilities and Works Committee

The third meeting (2025) of the Sai Kung District Council District Facilities and Works Committee (DFWC) was held on 13 May. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Report on management of recreation and sports facilities in Sai Kung District from March to April 2025 by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department

2. DFWC noted the above report and asked the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) and the Architectural Services Department to follow up Members' views on the "Construction works of Town Park in Area 68, Tseung Kwan O".

Report on community halls/ community centre/ activity centre in Sai Kung District

3. DFWC noted the above report and asked the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) to follow up Members' views.

Overview of projects under the District Minor Works Programme by the Sai Kung District Office

4. DFWC noted the above report, and asked LCSD and SKDO to follow up Members' views.

Suggest the Government and shopping centres to install additional road signage/ directional signage leading to the Saint Francis University

5. DFWC noted the written replies from the Transport Department (TD), the Metro Town Shopping Mall, the MTR Corporation Limited (MTRCL) and the Link Asset Management Limited (Link). Moreover, DFWC asked TD, Metro Town Shopping Mall, MTRCL and Link to follow up Members' views.

6. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest providing a post office and an iPostal station at the Anderson Road Development Area to enhance postal services

7. DFWC noted the written reply from the Hongkong Post (HKP) and asked HKP to follow up Members' views.

8. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Follow-up on slope safety in Sai Kung and Tseung Kwan O, and enquire about the progress of slope works in the district included in the Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Programme

9. DFWC noted the written reply from the Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD), and asked CEDD and the Environmental Protection Department to follow up Members' views.

10. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest exploring the introduction of a new route from the Po Pin Chau Viewing Platform directly to the dolosse and sea caves at East Dam

11. DFWC noted the written replies from the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) and the Water Supplies Department (WSD), and asked AFCD, WSD, TD and the Hong Kong Police Force to follow up Members' views.
