

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council
District Facilities and Works Committee**

The fourth meeting (2025) of the Sai Kung District Council District Facilities and Works Committee (DFWC) was held on 15 July. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Report on management of recreation and sports facilities in Sai Kung District from May to June 2025 by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department

2. DFWC noted the above report and asked the Leisure and Cultural Services Department to follow up Members' views.

Report on community halls/ community centre/ activity centre in Sai Kung District

3. DFWC noted the above report and asked the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) to follow up Members' views.

Landslip Prevention and Mitigation Programme - Works progress in Sai Kung District

4. DFWC noted the above report and asked the Civil Engineering and Development Department to follow up Members' views.

Suggest extending the current enhancement mechanism by allocating more public rental housing units in Tseung Kwan O to applicants residing in Tseung Kwan O or with elderly/ young family members residing in Tseung Kwan O

5. DFWC noted the written reply from the Housing Department (HD) and asked HD to follow up Members' views.

Suggest enhancing road surfaces within Sai Kung and Tseung Kwan O to create a more comfortable and safe road environment

7. DFWC noted the written reply from the Highways Department (HyD) and asked HyD to follow up Members' views.

8. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest providing covered benches and bicycle parking spaces on the pavement of Shek Kok Road (opposite the sewage treatment works)

9. DFWC noted the written replies from the Transport Department (TD) and SKDO, and asked TD and SKDO to follow up Members' views.

10. DFWC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest shortening the duration of escalator replacement works at Metro Town Shopping Mall

11. DFWC noted the written reply from Metro Town Shopping Mall, and asked Metro Town Shopping Mall and the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department to follow up Members' views.
