

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council
Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee**

The fifth meeting (2025) of the Sai Kung District Council Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee (FEHC) was held on 11 September. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Summary of District Consultation on the “Issues of Concern to Sai Kung District in 2025 – Environmental Hygiene” (Hygiene issues at piers and coastal areas and issues related to smoking)

2. FEHC noted the report from the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO), and the written replies from the Environmental Protection Department (EPD), the Marine Department (MD), the Drainage Services Department, the Tobacco and Alcohol Control Office (TACO) of the Department of Health (DH), and the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD). FEHC also asked EPD, MD, TACO, the Housing Department (HD), FEHD, the Transport Department, SKDO, and Link Asset Management Limited to follow up Members’ views.

3. FEHC noted the above reports.

Issues related to the operation of Temporary Fill Bank at Tseung Kwan O Area 137 and the South East New Territories Landfill

4. FEHC noted the above reports and asked the Civil Engineering and Development Department, EPD, FEHD, and the Highways Department to follow up Members’ views.

Statistics on Enforcement Actions by the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department Against Illegal Feeding of Wild Pigeons in Sai Kung District

5. FEHC noted the above report.

Express concern over the emergence of Chikungunya fever and suggest stepping up mosquito prevention and control measures in Sai Kung District and the Tseung Kwan O area

6. FEHC noted the written replies from DH, SKDO, HD, FEHD, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, and the Hospital Authority. FEHC also asked FEHD to follow up Members' views.

7. FEHC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest stepping up efforts to address the issue of water dripping from air conditioners in the Tseung Kwan O area

8. FEHC noted the written reply from FEHD, and asked FEHD to follow up Members' views.

9. FEHC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest relocating the refuse collection point next to the HHCKLA Buddhist Ching Kok Secondary School in Kin Ming Estate to tackle the problem of garbage and miscellaneous objects blocking the pavement and the school entrance/exit, thereby ensuring safe access by teachers and students as well as environmental hygiene

10. FEHC noted the written replies from FEHD and HD, and asked FEHD and HD to follow up Members' views.

11. FEHC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.
