

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council**  
**Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee**

The sixth meeting (2025) of the Sai Kung District Council Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee (FEHC) was held on 13 November. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Summary of District Consultation on the “Issues of Concern to Sai Kung District in 2025 – Environmental Hygiene” (Issues of dripping air conditioners and roadside potted plants)

2. FEHC noted the written replies from the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD), the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) and the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO).

Suggest enhancing source separation for recycling, and making good use of three-coloured waste separation bins

6. FEHC noted the written reply from the Environmental Protection Department (EPD), and asked EPD and FEHD to follow up Members’ views.

7. FEHC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest enhancing publicity in Sai Kung and Tseung Kwan O about the new arrangement of fees and charges for public hospitals to help citizens adapt more quickly

8. FEHC noted the written reply from the Hospital Authority (HA) and asked HA to follow up Members' views.

9. FEHC agreed to delete the above discussion item at the next meeting.

Suggest installing a smart surveillance system and audio warning facilities on the slope along Chui Ling Road in Tiu Keng Leng to address the issues of illegal feeding of wild animals and illegal cultivation

10. FEHC noted the written replies from AFCD, the Housing Department (HD) and the Highways Department (HyD), and asked AFCD, HD, HyD and the District Lands Office, Sai Kung to follow up Members' views.
