

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council
Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee**

The first meeting (2026) of the Sai Kung District Council Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee (FEHC) was held on 15 January. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:
