

**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council**  
**Traffic and Transport Committee**

The first meeting (2026) of the Sai Kung District Council Traffic and Transport Committee (TTC) was held on 22 January. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarised as follows:

Dualling of Hiram's Highway from Marina Cove to Sai Kung Town

Suggest providing a dedicated left-turn lane from Ying Yip Road onto Po Ning Road

Suggest the Transport Department to provide monitoring data and regularly review the effectiveness of the road improvement works at the roundabout at the junction of Ying Yip Road/Po Ning Road/Sheung Ning Road

Moreover, TTC asked CEDD to provide supplementary information regarding Members' enquiries, and asked CEDD and HKPF to follow up Members' views.
