7. Free Coach Parking in Ocean Park and related Traffic Arrangements

TD / Ocean Park Ocean Park is currently trying to free up more coach parking spaces as far as possible, and is encouraging coaches to enter Ocean Park during non-peak periods by offering free parking between 10am to 2pm on weekdays as well as free parking for the first 30 minutes thereafter to facilitate visitors to get on-and-off the coaches.

To maintain the current number of parking spaces for private cars and coaches during the construction period of Ocean Hotel and the Tai Shue Wan Waterpark, Ocean Park will rearrange parking spaces for private cars and coaches by converting some private car parking spaces into coach parking spaces, as well as converting the parking spaces used by Ocean Park vehicles and other areas within the Park into private car parking spaces. At the same time, Ocean Park has appointed a Transport Liaison Officer to closely liaise with travel agencies and carry out coordination work. The Park has also issued letters to travel agencies to encourage the latter to avoid arranging visits to the Park during after-school hours, so as not to aggravate the traffic loading in the surrounding areas.

According to the suggestions made by the Traffic and Transport Committee under SDC, Ocean Park will continue to work closely with the relevant Government departments including the Lands Department and Transport Department to explore the feasibility of using the works site of MTR South Island Line near Ocean Park's main entrance as a temporary carpark.

Ocean Park is currently working closely with the Traffic Consultant to explore more feasible solutions to alleviate traffic problems in the area surrounding Ocean Park, and the Park will submit the proposals to the Ocean Park Liaison Group of Traffic Issue in Southern District for consideration.

(B) **Bus Services in the District**

In general, crew shortage and traffic congestion were the major causes of the lost trips of above-mentioned bus routes, except for route nos. N72 and N170 whose high lost trip rates in February 2014 were caused by emergency incident, route no. 971R whose high lost trip rate in April 2014 was caused by inclement weather as well as route nos.70, 72, 93 and 93A whose high lost trip rates in September 2014 were caused by inclement weather and traffic congestion due to occupation of roads. TD will continue to monitor the service level of franchised buses, and when necessary, taking into account of the causes of the lost trips and passenger demand of individual route, work out improvement measures, including but not limited to time-table adjust to reflect the actual journey time, review on the designation of bus-only lane, review on effective periods of the no-stopping restricted zones. TD will also request the Police to take enforcement action to against illegal parking, and requested the bus operator to take remedial action to minimize lost trip rates caused by staff shortage.
