Report on the enlarged meeting of the  
Health and Environment Committee held on 8 May 2014

- (1) During the enlarged meeting, the councillors and Committee members discussed the paper on “Public Consultation on Enhanced Measures against Shop Front Extensions” submitted by the Home Affairs Department, and unanimously passed the following provisional motion:

“The Health and Environment Committee of the Sha Tin District Council urges the government to expedite the introduction of legislation on “Fixed Penalty System against Shop Front Extensions” and step up law enforcement, keeping the street in good and hygienic conditions by resolving the problem of shop front extensions.”

- (2) The Committee discussed the paper on “Strategy and Work for Improvement of Environmental Hygiene in Hong Kong” submitted by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department.
- (3) The Committee noted the response of government departments to matters arising from the previous meeting.
- (4) Owing to the absence of a quorum, the Chairman decided that the discussion papers on “New Measures to Combat Illegal Extension of Business Areas by Food Premises in Sha Tin District” and “Election of Co-opted Members of the Committee”, as well as the questions on “Nuisance Caused by Wild Monkeys in Sha Tin District”, “General Out-patient Clinic Services in Sha Tin District” and “Law Enforcement and Education Against Fly-Tipping”, would be adjourned until the next meeting, and that the papers on “Revised Member Lists of Working Groups under the Committee”, “2014/2015 Work Plans and Funding Applications of Working Groups under the Committee”, “Reports of Working Groups”, “2014/2015 Approved Estimates of Expenditure Head 4 under the Committee”, “Statistical Overview of Sha Tin District Environmental Hygiene Service (as at 31 March 2014)” and “Sha Tin District Anti-mosquito Campaign 2014 (Second Phase)” would be dealt with through circulation.
