- (i) proposal for enhancement of mobile library services in Sha Tin District submitted by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD);
  - (ii) revised member list of a working group under the Committee; and
  - (iii) proposals submitted by the Working Group on District Facilities Works, including:
    - (a) revised funding application for ST-DMW148 “Construction of a Sitting-out Area in Hung Mui Kuk”, with the amount being increased from \$492,000 to \$630,000; and
