Report on the meeting of the  
Health and Environment Committee held on 10 January 2013

(1) The Committee discussed the following:

- (i) reply of the Hospital Authority to the question on “Accident and Emergency Nurse Clinic”; and
- (ii) reply of the Environmental Protection Department to the question on “Water Quality of Shing Mun River”, and passed the following provisional motion unanimously:

“The Health and Environment Committee of the Sha Tin District Council strongly requests the government to review afresh and optimise the water quality objective and water sampling mechanism, so as to keep abreast of social development and further improve the water quality of Shing Mun River and Tolo Harbour.”

(2) The Committee endorsed the revised 2012/2013 Work Plan of the Committee’s Working Group on Cleanliness and Hygiene of Sha Tin District.
