Report on the meeting of the
Education and Welfare Committee held on 4 September 2012

- (1) The Committee discussed the request of Mr CHING Cheung-ying to add the agenda item “Discussing whether Secondary and Primary Schools in the District should Offer Courses on Moral and National Education”. Fail to obtain the agreement of over half of the members of the Committee present at the meeting, the request was rejected.
- (2) The Committee endorsed the following:
 - (i) Committee meeting schedule for 2013;
 - (ii) 2012/13 revised work plans of working groups under the Committee; and
 - (iii) funding application in the amount of \$111,000 for “Feast for the Elderly” and funding application in the amount of \$16,000 for “Elderly Menu Design Competition” submitted by the Working Group on Welfare of Senior Citizens.
