



Sha Tin District Council

Report on the enlarged meeting of the
Traffic and Transport Committee held on 6 November 2012

- (1) During the enlarged meeting, the councillors and Committee members discussed the *Progress Report on the Sha Tin to Central Link (SCL)* submitted by the Highways Department and the MTR Corporation Ltd (MTRC), and unanimously passed the provisional motion below:

“The Traffic and Transport Committee of the Sha Tin District Council strongly requests that for the sake of easy public access to the SCL Hin Keng Station, the government should consider building a connecting footbridge across the section of Che Kung Miu Road near Hin Keng Estate, and submit a feasibility study to the Council for discussion within six months.”

- (2) The Committee discussed the replies of the Highways Department, the Transport Department and the MTRC to the question on “Construction of Walkway Cover at Lok King Street”.
- (3) The Committee endorsed the following:
- (i) revised member list of the Committee’s Working Group on Development of Major Transport Infrastructures in Sha Tin District;
 - (ii) revised annual work plan of the Committee’s Working Group on Development of Major Transport Infrastructures in Sha Tin District;
 - (iii) proposed arrangements submitted by the Highways Department and the Transport Department regarding the “Plan of Constructing Cycling Tracks at the Section of Che Kung Miu Road between Mei Tin Road and Hin Keng Street”; and
 - (iv) cross-year funding application of the Working Group on Development of Major Transport Infrastructures in Sha Tin District in the amount of \$160,000 for “Study on Amelioration of Congestion on Tai Po Road – Sha Tin”.

- (4) The Committee noted the following:

- (i) progress report submitted by the Transport Department;
- (ii) minutes of meetings of the Committee's Working Group on Road Safety, Working Group on Development of Cycle Network, and Working Group on Development of Major Transport Infrastructures in Sha Tin District;
- (iii) financial position and activity progress of Expenditure 7 (Traffic and Transport);
- (iv) report on the progress of works of the Highways Department;
- (v) population of public housing estates and Private Sector Participation Scheme courts in Sha Tin District; and
- (vi) prosecution figures on traffic offences in Sha Tin town centre.
