Traffic and Transport Committee
held on 13 April 2015 and 5 May 2015 respectively

A. Report on the special (enlarged) meeting held on 13 April 2015

During the special (enlarged) meeting, the councillors and Committee members discussed *Sha Tin District Bus Route Development Programme 2015-2016* submitted by the Transport Department.

B. Report on the meeting held on 5 May 2015

(1) The Committee discussed the following:

- (i) *Improvements to Existing Cycle Tracks and Cycle Parking Facilities in New Towns and Review of Existing Bicycle Prohibition Zones – Feasibility Study* submitted by the Transport Department, and passed this paper unanimously;
- (ii) *Progress Report on Road T3 and Associated Roadworks - Tai Po Road Slip Road near Scenery Court* submitted by the Civil Engineering and Development Department; and
- (iii) Draft of “Study on Existing Bus Stop Facilities in Sha Tin” submitted by the Working Group on Development of Major Transport Infrastructures in Sha Tin District.

(2) The Committee noted the response of government departments and organisations to matters arising from the previous meeting.

(3) Owing to the absence of a quorum, the Chairman decided that the motion “Requesting the MTRC to Freeze Fares and Provide Various Fare Concessions”

and the questions on “Capacity of Bus Termini in Sha Tin District”, “Bus-bus Interchange Concession and Tunnel Interchange Stations in Sha Tin District”, “Improvement of Facilities at Exits C and D of MTR Fo Tan Station”, “Requesting an Increase of Minibus Seats to 20” and “Potential Safety Hazards of Roundabouts in Sha Tin District” respectively would be dealt with at the next meeting, and that “Annual Work Plans and Funding Applications Submitted by Working Groups under the Committee”, “Progress Report of the Transport Department”, “Reports of Working Groups”, “2015-2016 Approved Estimates of an Expenditure Head under the Committee”, “Report on the Progress of Works of the Highways Department”, “Population of Public Housing Estates and Private Sector Participation Scheme Courts in Sha Tin” and “Prosecution Figures on Traffic Offences in Sha Tin and Tai Wai Town Centres” would be dealt with through circulation of papers.
