Report on the meeting of the
Finance and General Affairs Committee held on 12 July 2016

- (1) The Committee discussed the replies of the Sha Tin District Council Secretariat, the Home Affairs Department, the Sha Tin District Office, the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and HULU Culture to the question on “Fusion of Horizons”.
