Report on the meeting of the
District Facilities Management Committee held on 25 April 2017

- (1) The Committee discussed the responses of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) and the Hong Kong Police Force to the question on “the Enforcement of the *Pleasure Grounds Regulation*”.
- (2) Since the Home Affairs Department did not send representatives to the meeting, Mr YUNG Ming-chau, Michael suggested that the question on “District Administration, Venue Management and Law Enforcement at Venues” be dealt with at the next meeting. The Chairman agreed.
- (3) The Committee endorsed the following:
 - (i) the partitioning and hiring arrangements of the hall and conference room of the Yuen Chau Kok Community Hall; and
 - (ii) the following two new project proposals and the funding arrangements:
