Report on the Meeting of the
District Facilities Management Committee held on 29 August 2017

- (1) The Committee discussed the following:
 - (i) the replies of the Civil Service Bureau, the Home Affairs Department, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD), the Hong Kong Police Force and the Sha Tin District Council Secretariat to the question on “District Administration, Venue Management and Law Enforcement at Venues”; and
 - (ii) the replies of the LCSD and the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department to the question on “Management of Flower Beds by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department”.
- (2) The Committee endorsed the following:
 - (i) the meeting schedule of the committee for 2018;
 - (ii) the proposals and funding arrangements for the extension of opening hours of Yuen Chau Kok Community Hall, including:
 - (a) extending the opening time of Yuen Chau Kok Community Hall from 9 am to as early as 7 am from January 2018 to March 2019;
 - (b) earmarking \$22,822, \$136,931 and \$11,411 for financial years 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 respectively to pay for operating expenses totalling \$171,164; and
 - (c) granting special approval for extending the completion date of the activities under the funding applications mentioned above to 31 March 2019;
 - (iii) revising the amount of the funding application regarding ST-DMW387 “the map plate at the entrance of Lok Lo Ha Village” from \$50,000 to \$80,000;
