Report on Resumption of the Meeting of the  
Health and Environment Committee held on 15 January 2019

- (1) The Committee discussed and passed the following provisional motion on “Wild Pig Management Action Strategies” submitted by the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD):

“In view of the persistent nuisance caused by wild pigs which has brought hygiene problem and threatened the safety of residents, the Health and Environment Committee of the Sha Tin District Council urges the Government to consider introducing legislation to impose severe punishment on persons who feed wild pigs so as to reduce the food source, as well as increasing the manpower, providing additional monitoring equipment and extending the coverage of monitoring area, with a view to having a more efficient control of the growth in the number of wild pigs.”  
(Unanimously passed).

- (2) The Committee discussed the following:
