Report on the meeting of the
District Facilities Management and Security Affairs Committee held on 24 June 2020

- (1) The Committee endorsed 6 new works proposals and relevant funding applications as follows:

- (2) The Committee discussed the replies of the Highways Department, the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department, the Lands Department and the Hong Kong Police Force on the question of “Display of Publicity Materials in Public Places”, and passed the following provisional motion:

“The District Facilities Management and Security Affairs Committee of the Sha Tin District Council demands that the police refrain from arresting or prosecuting individuals based on their political stance and cease all unsubstantiated or unreasonable arrests and prosecutions. The police should expeditiously take effective enforcement actions to root out the long-term problem of extensive posting of property advertisements and use of graffiti to advertise ‘repairs on induction cookers’ in public places perpetrated by the same group of people.” (Unanimously passed)
