Report on the meeting of the  
Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee held on 29 April 2021

- (1) The Committee endorsed the following:
  - (i) 2021-22 Leisure and Cultural Services Department Annual Work Plan - Progress of Capital Works Projects Related to Leisure and Cultural Services Facilities in Sha Tin;
  - (ii) updated membership list of working group under the Committee;
  - (iii) the proposed earmarked provision and funding applications from local organisations under Expenditure Head 1 (Cultural Affairs) of 2021/2022 totalling \$2,787,068;
