# Tuen Mun District Crime Report for Tuen Mun District Council Meeting Covering the Period of 2023

#### I. GENERAL SITUATION

#### 1. Overall Crime

#### (Comparison between 2023 and 2022)

- (1) There were 4,273 crime reports in 2023, up 675 reports or +18.8% compared with 3,598 reports in 2022. The rise was mainly due to the increase of:
  - Deception (up from 1,470 to 1,758 reports) (+288 reports / +19.6%) [accounting for 41.4% of total crimes];
  - Shop Theft (up from 528 to 588 reports) (+60 reports / +11.4%) [accounting for 13.8% of total crimes]; and
  - Criminal Damage (up from 294 to 351 reports) (+57 reports / +19.4%) [accounting for 8.2% of total crimes].

In 2023, crimes showing significant decrease were:

- Serious Narcotics Offences (down from 57 to 43 reports) (-14 reports / -24.6%) [accounting for 1% of total crimes]; and
- Homicide Offences (down from 3 to 1 report) (-2 reports / -66.7%) [accounting for 0.02% of total crimes].
- (2) The detection rate in 2023 was 37.8%, up 4.5% compared with 33.3% in 2022.

#### (Comparison between 2023 and 2018)

- (3) There were 4,273 crime reports in 2023, up 1,321 reports or +44.7% compared with 2,952 reports in 2018. The rise was mainly due to the increase of:
  - Deception (up from 456 to 1,758 reports) (+1,302 reports / +285.5%) [accounting for 41.4% of total crimes];
  - Shop Theft (up from 515 to 588 reports) (+73 reports / +14.2%) [accounting for 13.8% of total crimes]; and
  - Indecent Assault (up from 60 to 85 reports) (+25 reports / +41.7%) [accounting for 2% of total crimes].

In 2018, crimes showing significant decrease were:

- Miscellaneous Thefts (down from 570 to 459 reports) (-111 reports / -19.5%) [accounting for 10.7% of total crimes];
- Wounding & Serious Assault (down from 282 to 236 report) (-46 reports / -16.3%) [accounting for 5.5% of total crimes]; and
- Serious Narcotics Offences (down from 64 to 43 reports) (-21 reports / -32.8%) [accounting for 1% of total crimes]
- (4) The detection rate in 2023 was 37.8%, down 9.4% compared with 47.2% in 2018.

# (Comparison between 2023 and 2022)

- (1) There were 554 violent crime reports in 2023, up 93 reports or +20.2% compared with 461 reports in 2022.
- (2) The detection rate of violent crime was 63.9%, up 8.6% compared with 55.3% in 2022.

#### (Comparison between 2023 and 2018)

- (3) There were 554 violent crime reports in 2023, up 21 reports or +3.9% compared with 533 reports in 2018.
- (4) The detection rate of violent crime was 63.9%, down 2.9% compared with 66.8% in 2018.

- (2) In 2023, 71 persons were arrested for serious narcotics offences, down 30 persons or -29.7% compared with 101 persons in 2022, and down 16 persons or -18.4% compared with 87 persons in 2018.
- (3) In 2023, 2 juveniles were arrested for serious narcotics offences, up 2 persons compared with no person arrested in 2022 and 2018.

(1) There were 15 pickpocketing reports in 2023, up 11 reports or +275% compared with 4 reports in 2022, and down 1 report or -6.3% compared with 16 reports in 2018.

# c) Shop Theft

(1) There were 588 shop theft reports in 2023, up 60 reports or +11.4% compared with 528 reports in 2022, and up 73 reports or +14.2% compared with 515 reports in 2018.

#### d) Theft from Vehicle

(1) There were 57 theft from vehicle reports in 2023, up 12 reports or +26.7% compared with 45 reports in 2022, and up 4 reports or +7.5% compared with 53 reports in 2018.

#### e) <u>Miscellaneous Thefts</u>

(1) There were 459 miscellaneous thefts reports in 2023, up 22 reports or +5% compared with 437 reports in 2022, and down 111 reports or -19.5% compared with 570 reports in 2018.

#### f) Missing Motor Vehicles

(1) There were 51 motor vehicles reported missing in 2023, up 1 report or +2% compared with 50 reports in 2022, and up 22 reports or +75.9% compared with 29 reports in 2018.
