I. GENERAL SITUATION

1. Overall Crime

- There were 1,128 crime reports in Jar Mar 2025, down 205 reports or -15.4% compared with 1,333 reports in the same period last year. The drop was mainly due to the decrease of:
 - Miscellaneous Thefts (down from 162 to 118 reports) (-44 reports / -27.2%)

[accounting for 10.5% of total crimes];

- Criminal Damage (down from 90 to 56 reports) (-34 reports / -37.8%) [accounting for 5% of total crimes]; and
- Shop Theft (down from 154 to 129 reports) (-25 reports / -16.2%) [accounting for 11.4% of total crimes].

In Jan – Mar 2025, crimes showing significant increase were:

- Deception (up from 563 to 571 reports) (+8 reports / +1.4%) [accounting for 50.6% of total crimes];
- Burglary (up from 7 to 12 reports) (+5 reports / +71.4%) [accounting for 1.1% of total crimes]; and
- Missing Motor Vehicles (up from 11 to 13 reports) (+2 reports / +18.2%) [accounting for 1.2% of total crimes].
- (2) The detection rate in Jan Mar 2025 was 34%, up 3.4% compared with 30.6% in the same period last year.

2. <u>Violent Crime¹</u>
