Covering the Period from January 2025 to March 2026

I. GENERAL SITUATION

1. Overall Crime

(Comparison between Jan - Mar 2026 and the same period last year)

(1) There were 1,211 crime reports in Jan – Mar 2026, up 83 reports or +7.4% compared with 1,128 reports in the same period last year. The rise was mainly due to the increase of:

- Deception (up from 571 to 678 reports) (+107 reports / +18.7%) [accounting for 56% of total crimes];
- Shop Theft (up from 129 to 138 reports) (+9 reports / +7%) [accounting for 11.4% of total crimes]; and
- Serious Narcotics Offences (up from 10 to 12 reports) (+2 reports / +20%) [accounting for 1% of total crimes].

In Jan – Mar 2026, crimes showing significant decrease were:

- Miscellaneous Thefts (down from 118 to 108 reports) (-10 reports / -8.5%) [accounting for 8.9% of total crimes];
- Missing Motor Vehicles (down from 13 to 3 reports) (-10 reports / -76.9%) [accounting for 0.2% of total crimes]; and
- Theft from Vehicle (down from 10 to 4 reports) (-6 reports / -60%) [accounting for 0.3% of total crimes].

(2) The detection rate in Jan – Mar 2026 was 32.2%, down 1.8% compared with 34% in the same period last year.

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2. Violent Crime¹

- (1) There were 114 violent crime reports in Jan – Mar 2026, down 3 reports or -2.6% compared with 117 reports in the same period last year.
- (2) The detection rate of violent crime was 71.9%, down 1.6% compared with 73.5% in the same period last year.

- (1) There were 138 shop theft reports in Jan – Mar 2026, up 9 reports or +7% compared with 129 reports in the same period last year.

d) Theft from Vehicle

- (1) There were 4 theft from vehicle reports in Jan – Mar 2026, down 6 reports or -60% compared with 10 reports in the same period last year.

e) Miscellaneous Thefts

- (1) There were 108 miscellaneous thefts reports in Jan – Mar 2026, down 10 reports or -8.5% compared with 118 reports in the same period last year.

f) Missing Motor Vehicles

- (1) There were 3 motor vehicles reported missing in Jan – Mar 2026, down 10 reports or -76.9% compared with 13 reports in the same period last year.

(3) There were 192 telephone deception reports in Jan – Mar 2026, up 91 reports or +90.1% compared with 101 reports in the same period last year. Among which 191 reports had actual loss incurred with the accumulated amount of HK\$33,203,992.

³ In Jan – Mar 2026, the raise to 678 reports of deception was mainly due to the increase of:

- Telephone Deception (up from 101 to 192 reports, $\uparrow 91/\uparrow 90.1\%$)
- Online Shopping (up from 190 to 230 reports, $\uparrow 40/\uparrow 21.1\%$)
- Online Account Hijacking (up from 10 to 40 reports, $\uparrow 30/\uparrow 300\%$)
