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**Tuen Mun District Crime Report for
Tuen Mun District Council Meeting
Covering the Period from January 2025 to Jul 2026**

I. GENERAL SITUATION

1. Overall Crime

(Comparison between 2025 and 2024)

- (1) There were 5,216 crime reports in 2025, down 565 reports or -9.8% compared with 5,781 reports in 2024. The drop was mainly due to the decrease of:
- Criminal Damage (down from 347 to 240 reports) (-107 reports / -30.8%) [accounting for 4.6% of total crimes];
 - Deception (down from 2,939 to 2,861 reports) (-78 reports / -2.7%) [accounting for 54.9% of total crimes]; and
 - Miscellaneous Thefts (down from 565 to 490 reports) (-75 reports / -13.3%) [accounting for 9.4% of total crimes].

In 2025, crimes showing significant increase were:

- Indecent Assault (up from 76 to 87 reports) (+11 reports / +14.5%) [accounting for 1.7% of total crimes];
- Missing Motor Vehicles (up from 34 to 43 reports) (+9 reports / +26.5%) [accounting for 0.8% of total crimes]; and
- Theft from Vehicle (up from 24 to 30 reports) (+6 reports / +25%) [accounting for 0.6% of total crimes].

- (2) The detection rate in 2025 was 34.8%, down 1.7% compared with 36.5% in 2024.

(Comparison between Jan - Jul 2026 and the same period last year)

(3) There were 2,963 crime reports in Jan – Jul 2026, down 14 reports or -0.5% compared with 2,977 reports in the same period last year. The drop was mainly due to the decrease of:

- Criminal Damage (down from 149 to 112 reports) (-37 reports / -24.8%) [accounting for 3.8% of total crimes];
- Wounding and Serious Assault (down from 125 to 95 reports)(-30 reports / -24%) [accounting for 3.2% of total crimes]; and
- Missing Motor Vehicles (down from 34 to 7 reports) (-27 reports / -79.4%) [accounting for 0.2% of total crimes].

In Jan – Jul 2026, crimes showing significant increase were:

- Deception (up from 1,605 to 1,768 reports) (+163 reports / +10.2%) [accounting for 59.7% of total crimes];
- Shop Theft (up from 275 to 302 reports) (+27 reports / +9.8%) [accounting for 10.2% of total crimes];
- Serious Narcotics Offences (up from 26 to 28 reports) (+2 reports / +7.7%) [accounting for 0.9% of total crimes]; and
- Burglary (up from 21 to 23 reports) (+2 reports / +9.5%) [accounting for 0.8% of total crimes].

(4) The detection rate in Jan – Jul 2026 was 28.5%, down 2.7% compared with 31.2% in the same period last year.

- (1) There were 529 violent crime reports in 2025, down 182 reports or -25.6% compared with 711 reports in 2024.
- (2) The detection rate of violent crime in 2025 was 72.6%, up 13.5% compared with 59.1% in 2024.

(Comparison between Jan - Jul 2026 and the same period last year)

- (3) There were 258 violent crime reports in Jan – Jul 2026, down 72 reports or -21.8% compared with 330 reports in the same period last year.
- (4) The detection rate of violent crime was 74.4%, up 1.7% compared with 72.7% in the same period last year.

- (1) There were 54 serious narcotics reports in 2025, up 3 reports or +5.9% compared with 51 reports in 2024.
- (2) In 2025, 73 persons were arrested for serious narcotics offences, down 2 persons or -2.7% compared with 75 persons in 2024.
- (3) In 2025, 2 juveniles were arrested for serious narcotics offences, up 1 person or +100% compared with 1 person in 2024.
- (4) In 2025, 14 young persons were arrested for serious narcotics offences, up 10 persons or +250% compared with 4 persons in 2024.

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- (5) There were 28 serious narcotics reports in Jan – Jul 2026, up 2 reports or +7.7% compared with 26 reports in the same period last year.
- (6) In Jan – Jul 2026, 45 persons were arrested for serious narcotics offences, up 4 persons or +9.8% compared with 41 persons in the same period last year.
- (7) In Jan – Jul 2026, no juvenile was arrested for serious narcotics offences, down 2 persons or -100% compared with 2 juveniles were arrested in the same period last year.
- (8) In Jan – Jul 2026, 8 young persons were arrested for serious narcotics offences, which is unchanged from the same period last year.

a) Snatching

- (1) There were 3 snatching reports in 2025, up 1 report or +50% compared with 2 reports in 2024.
- (2) There was no snatching reports in Jan – Jul 2026, which is unchanged from the same period last year.

b) Pickpocketing

- (1) There were 5 pickpocketing reports in 2025, down 21 reports or -80.8% compared with 26 reports in 2024.
- (2) There was 2 pickpocketing reports in Jan – Jul 2026, down 1 report or -33.3% compared with 3 reports in the same period last year.

c) Shop Theft

- (1) There were 511 shop theft reports in 2025, down 74 reports or -12.6% compared with 585 reports in 2024.
- (2) There were 302 shop theft reports in Jan – Jul 2026, up 27 reports or +9.8% compared with 275 reports in the same period last year.

d) Theft from Vehicle

- (1) There were 30 theft from vehicle reports in 2025, up 6 reports or +25% compared with 24 reports in 2024.
- (2) There were 10 theft from vehicle reports in Jan – Jul 2026, down 11 reports or -52.4% compared with 21 reports in the same period last year.

e) Miscellaneous Thefts

- (1) There were 490 miscellaneous thefts reports in 2025, down 75 reports or -13.3% compared with 565 reports in 2024.
- (2) There were 248 miscellaneous thefts reports in Jan – Jul 2026, down 16 reports or -6.1% compared with 264 reports in the same period last year.

f) Missing Motor Vehicles

- (1) There were 43 motor vehicles reported missing in 2025, up 9 reports or +26.5% compared with 34 reports in 2024.

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- (3) There were 1,768 deception reports in Jan – Jul 2026, up 163³ reports or +10.2% compared with 1,605 reports in the same period last year, the total amount of stolen property involved is HK\$240,304,026.

Telephone Deception

- (5) There were 747 telephone deception reports in 2025, up 43 reports or +6.1% compared with 704 reports in 2024. Among which 733 reports had actual loss incurred with the accumulated amount of HK\$100,762,258.
- (6) There were 560 telephone deception reports in Jan – Jul 2026, up 180 reports or +47.4% compared with 380 reports in the same period last year. Among which 559 reports had actual loss incurred with the accumulated amount of HK\$76,142,111.

³ In Jan – Jul 2026, the raise to 1,768 reports of deception was mainly due to the increase of:

- Telephone Deception (up from 380 to 560 reports, ↑180/↑47.4%)
- Online Shopping (up from 507 to 611 reports, ↑104/↑20.5%)
- Online Account Hijacking (up from 34 to 128 reports, ↑94/↑276.5%)
