The Meeting

I Opening Remarks and Introduction

The Chairman welcomed the Members and representatives from the government departments to the 19th meeting of the Culture, Recreation and Sports Committee (CRSC). He introduced Ms SIU Yuen-ching, Sara, who attended the meeting for the first time and replaced Mr CHUNG Tak-yau to assume the post of Deputy District Leisure Manager(Tsuen Wan)¹ of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

2. The Chairman said that for Members' information, Mr LAM Faat-kang was absent with apologies.

3. The Chairman reminded Members that according to section 28 of the Tsuen Wan District Council Standing Orders (the "Standing Orders"), unless otherwise agreed by the Chairman, each Member could speak and make supplementary remarks once for each agenda item at the meeting. Each Member could speak up to three minutes each time.

(Note: Mr MAN Yu-ming joined the meeting at 2:34 p.m.)

4. The Chairman reminded Members that according to section 15(3) of the Standing Orders, "in the course of a meeting of the Council, all persons attending or sitting in on the meeting at the place of the meeting shall switch off all devices which may emit sound and shall not use any telecommunications devices for conversation" in order to ensure the smooth progress of the meeting.

II Item 1: Confirmation of Minutes of the Meeting held on 8.11.2018

5. The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously confirmed by Members without amendment.

III Item 2: Matters Arising from the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

6. The Chairman said that there were no matters arising from the minutes of the previous meeting.

IV Item 3: Work Progress Report of Various Working Groups under the Committee and Sponsored Organisations

(A) Culture, Arts, Recreation & Sports Development Group

7. Mr CHAN Chun-chung, Jones reported that the preliminary contest and semi-final of the “6th ‘Melodious Voice from Tsuen Wan’ Singing Contest” which was the last activity co-organised by the Culture, Arts, Recreation and Sports Development Group in the current financial year were held on 18 November 2018 and 16 December 2018 respectively. The grand final would be held at the Auditorium of the Tsuen Wan Town Hall on 20 January 2019.

(B) Working Group on Activities under Cultural, Recreation and Sports Committee

8. The Chairman reported that the final contest of the “Dance Parade in Tsuen Wan Vol. 2.0” co-organised by the Working Group on Activities under Cultural, Recreation and Sports Committee was successfully completed on 8 December 2018. In addition, the “Night Concert of the Year of the Pig in Tsuen Wan” which was the last activity co-organised by the Working Group on Activities under Cultural, Recreation and Sports Committee in the current financial year would be held at the Auditorium of the Tsuen Wan Town Hall on 11 February 2019 and the ballot for the distribution of admission tickets was completed.

(C) Tsuen Wan Culture and Recreation Co-ordinating Association (TWCR) (Sponsored Organisation)

9. The Chairman reported that the TWCR had no special business to report.

(D) Federation of Tsuen Wan District Sports and Recreation Association (TWDSRA) (Sponsored Organisation)

10. Mr YAU Kam-ping reported that the TWDSRA had no special business to report.

(E) Tsuen Wan Sports Festival Co-ordinating Committee (TWSFCC) (Sponsored Organisation)

11. The Secretary reported that the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival was held successfully from 21 October 2018 to 23 December 2018. A total of six sports events were held in the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival, including the Opening Ceremony cum Castle Peak Road Vitality Run 2018, Tsuen Wan Area Inter-Primary School Table Tennis Competition, Tsuen Wan Rural Committee Elite Soccer Competition, Tsuen Wan Area Inter-school Badminton Competition, Tsuen Wan Area Inter-Secondary School 3-on-3 Basketball Competition and Closing Ceremony cum Rock Climbing Competition. For Members’ information, the commemorative publication of the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival was under preparation. The successful completion of the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival was achieved upon the concerted efforts of the government departments as well as the dedication and participation of various sectors in Tsuen Wan. The TWSFCC thanked all Members for supporting the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival.

12. The Chairman said that he participated in the Closing Ceremony cum Rock Climbing Competition which was held in the newly commissioned Tsuen Wan Sports Centre. He was intrigued by rock climbing. Although it was rainy on the day of the competition, the participants of the Men's and Women's Open Divisions had demonstrated sportsmanship and successfully completed the competition. He appreciated that a good progress was made in the 28th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival and hoped that the TWSFCC would keep up the good work for the 29th Tsuen Wan Sports Festival.

(F) Tsuen Wan Football Association (TWFA) (Sponsored Organisation)

13. Mr YAU Kam-ping reported that the Training Course for Children and Youth Players co-organised by the TWFA and ChelseaFC Soccer School (HK) was successfully completed a few days ago and was well-received.

V Item 4: Any Other Business

(A) Report on Preparatory Work of the 7th Hong Kong Games

14. The Chairman reported the latest progress of the preparation for and activity updates on the 7th Hong Kong Games, including the selection of athletes in Tsuen Wan district, Cheering Team trainings and "The Jockey Club Vitality Run".
