Progress Report on District Minor Works in 2014-15  
(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 2/2015)

District Facilities Management Committee (DFMC) had suspended its vetting of the revised funding application for the works project “Provision of a Rain Shelter at Shatin Pass Road near Hsin Kuang Footbridge” (WTS-DMW171). While generally endorsing the provision of a rain shelter at the said location, Members urged the Wong Tai Sin District Office (WTSDO) to arrange a post-meeting site visit for the works project as soon as possible so as to re-identify a suitable location for provision of the rain shelter. On the morning of 29 January 2015, the post-meeting site visit was arranged for Members and the technical staff of Home Affairs Department (HAD), and a suitable location for provision of rain shelter was identified. DFMC had, on 13 February 2015, endorsed the revised design of the rain shelter by circulation of paper. WTSDO was, at the current stage, collecting information concerning the underground utilities and making preparations for pit excavation.

Proposed Funding Allocation for the Implementation of District Minor Works in 2014-15  
(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 3/2015)

2. DFMC endorsed the funding applications proposed for works projects “Provision of Two Rain Shelters outside Kam Wan House” (WTS-DMW176) and “Provision of a Covered Walkway outside Pik Hoi House” (WTS-DMW177), with allocation of fund totaling \$500,000 for the preliminary feasibility studies.

Allocation of WTSDC Funds for Community Involvement Projects to be Implemented by the District Facilities Management Committee in 2014-15  
(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 4/2015)

3. DFMC endorsed the funding application for the Hong Kong Flower Show 2015 – Green Stall and the sum allocated was \$10,000.

Recreational and Sports Activities to be Organised by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in Wong Tai Sin in 2015-16

(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 6/2015)

4. DFMC endorsed the proposed recreational and sports activities set out in paragraphs 5 to 11 and the allocation of \$3,838,700 for the recreational and sports activities to be organised by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) between April and December 2015 as proposed in paragraphs 12 to 15 of the Paper. It was also endorsed in principle that a sum of \$588,300 would be allocated from the funding provision for DFMC under the new term of Wong Tai Sin District Council for payment of the expenditures incurred from the activities organised between January and March 2016 and that the estimated expenditure of \$190,000 incurred from the activities organised in March 2016 would be met in the financial year of 2016-2017.

District Free Entertainment Programmes to be Provided by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in Wong Tai Sin in 2015/16

(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 7/2015)

5. DFMC endorsed the proposed district free entertainment programmes for the year of 2015-16 set out in Appendix III and the allocation of \$310,500 for the district free entertainment programmes to be provided by the LCSD in Wong Tai Sin District between April and December 2015, as proposed in paragraphs 8 to 11 of the Paper. It was also endorsed in principle that a sum of \$98,000 would be allocated from the funding provision for DFMC under the new term of Wong Tai Sin District Council for payment of the expenditures incurred from the programmes provided between January and March 2016 and that the estimated expenditures of \$28,700 incurred from the programmes provided in March 2016 would be met in the financial year of 2016-2017.

Promotional Activities for Public Libraries in Wong Tai Sin to be Organised by the District Facilities Management Committee from April 2014 to March 2015

(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 8/2015)

6. DFMC endorsed the promotional activities for public libraries in Wong Tai Sin as set out in Appendix II and the allocation of \$70,560 for the promotional activities for public libraries in Wong Tai Sin to be organised by the LCSD in April to December 2015, as proposed in paragraphs 5 to 6 of the Paper. It was also endorsed in principle that a sum of \$19,875 would be allocated from the funding provision for DFMC under the new term of Wong Tai Sin District Council for payment of the expenditures incurred from the activities organised between January and March 2016, and that the estimated expenditures of \$5,565 incurred from the activities organised in March 2016 would be met in the financial year of 2016-2017.

Review on the Arrangements on the Use of Partitions in the Multi-purpose Hall of Tung Tau Community Centre  
(WTSDC DFMC Paper No. 13/2015)

7. DFMC endorsed the cancellation of arrangements on the use of partitions in the multi-purpose hall of Tung Tau Community Centre. WSTDO had revised the “Guidelines on the Use of Community Centres / Community Hall in Wong Tai Sin” and informed in early February 2015 the local organisations of the cancellation of the arrangements with effect from 1 March 2015. The relevant notice was also posted on the notice board of Tung Tau Community Centre.

Any Other Business

8. DFMC requested the Housing Department to study whether it would provide some covered seats outside Lung Hing House of Lower Wong Tai Sin Estate.
